A rare talent proficient in over ten traditional Chinese instruments—most notably Dizi and Xiao—Jennifer has received more than 50 prestigious gold awards, including Best Asian Entertainer at the Chicago Music Awards, Best Artist at the Chinese Songwriter Contest in the US, and Best Music Video Award at the US-China Film Festival.

Jennifer is also the winner of five coveted international titles, including Miss Friendship Ambassador of Chicago, Miss China International, and Brilliant Miss World. Her performances have graced over 800

international stages, including the Bloomberg Global Business Forum, where she has performed for world leaders and luminaries such as President Barack Obama, Vice President JD Vance, Bill Gates, Jensen Huang, Jack Ma, and Anna Wintour.

An honors graduate of Northwestern University and Founder of NU Club of China (the official alumni club for her proud alma mater), she continues to redefine the role of the modern cultural ambassador on the world stage.

MICHELLE BATOMALAUQUE



Michelle Batomalaque is a visual artist from Cawayan, Impasugong, Bukidnon, whose creative practice is deeply rooted in the highlands where she was born and raised. Her art radiates faith, gratitude, and reverence for life's quiet beauty—expressed through a medium as humble and profound as soil. For Michelle, painting with earth is both a spiritual and cultural act, anchoring her work to the land that shaped her and the ancestral stories it holds.

Her pieces reflect the core values of the Luman people—kindness, respect, and unity—while also illuminating their enduring connection to nature, ancestral territory, and traditional governance under Datus and Baes. In the face of modern influences, Michelle's art stands as a testament to the Luman's resilience and spiritual continuity.

At the heart of her visual language are signature figures, often shown kneeling within circular forms. These motifs evoke humility, prayer, and offering—symbols of sacred communion between Creator and creation. Each painting becomes a quiet invocation, a whispered story, and a gesture of thanksgiving.

Guided by the spirit of her homeland, Michelle believes that even from the soil beneath our feet, beauty and hope can rise. Through her soil paintings, she shares not only the soul of Bukidnon, but also her own.
